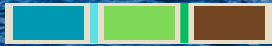

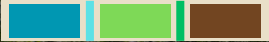
ABOUT TERRA PAPUA

Promoting Indigenous leadership and well-being by developing sustainable livelihoods and strengthening local resource management rights.



Integrating forest and marine ecosystem management through a ridge-to-reef approach to maintain ecological connectivity and climate resilience.



Developing multi-stakeholder partnerships and innovative conservation financing through strategic collaboration with government and the private sector.

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WHY THESE AREAS MATTER



Raja Ampat

Raja Ampat is a globally significant biodiversity hotspot with immense potential for conservation, sustainable development, scientific discovery and Indigenous-led stewardship. At the same time growing tourism, development pressures, and competing resource interests challenge its ecological integrity, equitable benefits for local communities and strengthen indigenous rights and leadership



Bomberay Corridor

The Bomberay Corridor, encompassing Kaimana and Fakfak, holds significant potential for biodiversity conservation, sustainable resource management, and Indigenous-led OECMs. Yet realizing this potential remains challenging amid gaps in MPA management, sustainable financing, and recognition of Indigenous stewardship systems.



Crown Jewel of Papua

The Crown Jewel of Papua is a globally significant landscape of intact forests, rich biodiversity, and Indigenous territories, offering immense potential for conservation and sustainable development. Yet managing this vast landscape presents complex challenges, from balancing conservation and development to strengthening Indigenous stewardship and collaborative governance across jurisdictions.



FROM FOCUS TO SCALE

In its first three years, Terra Papua will prioritize advancing the Raja Selamanya initiative in Raja Ampat, while strengthening its foundation across its three priority areas. This focused approach will generate practical experience, partnerships, and scalable solutions that can support Indigenous-led conservation and sustainable natural resource management across Papua.
